Key Expectations



There will be many new expectations of your child in years 10 and 11 – expectations which for many are hard to meet. However, you do not need to know anything about maths, science or textiles to help them with these things – you've been doing it all of their lives!

New demands on your child are likely to include:

- Being more self-motivated and taking more responsibility for their own learning
- Asking when they do not understand.
- Developing their abilities to overcome frustrations, and strategies for persisting when they are learning material that they find challenging.
- Organising themselves, notes, handouts and information for different subjects, and different topics within subjects.
- Completing more work at home, independently.
- Organising and planning their time over longer periods.
- Understanding the exam structure and the relative importance of each piece of work to their final grade.
- Planning and carrying out their revision.
- Perfecting "exam technique"

Key Information

- Dates Mon 8th to Fri 19th July 2024
- **Provider** Bromley Education Business Partnership (BEBP)
- Info Letters/ Guidance/ Placement Forms emailed home 10th October and all information will also be available on Year 10 TEAMS
- In 2023 over 249 placements were arranged. Only about 10% were found by the school
- **Meaning that 90% (over 4 in every 5)** were found by students, their parent/carers, their wider family and their family friends
- Most Bexley & Bromley Schools have their WEx at the same time so places are limited.

Key Actions

To get the most out of these two weeks

- Start straight away write letters and prepare a CV to send out to employers. Try to get a
 placement organised by Christmas 2023. This will make the experience less stressful for
 you.
- Deadline Monday 19th February 2024 for placements to be found and the details to be returned to Mrs Smith in Room 106 to be forwarded to BEBP.

NB - The longer students leave it, the less chance they will have of finding a suitable placement

What you need to know

- 2 x 1 week placements there maybe a charge of £50 if the 2nd placement does not have a visit in place by BEBP.
- Insurance placements must have the appropriate Employer's Liability Insurance,
 PLEASE CHECK THIS otherwise it will not be authorised by either the School or our provider
- Hours worked varies but NOT school hours
- This is not a holiday You cannot use these two weeks to organise a family holiday or it will be an unauthorised absence. This will be mentioned in any Post 16 references.
- Liz Wyn-Owen is your Independent Careers Advisor
- She is in school every Wednesday, for the whole day
- All KS4 students are invited to a 1-to-5 group careers interview before the end of Year 10
- You can request a 1-2-1 careers interview with Liz at any time See Mrs Smith, Tue, Wed or Thurs in Room 106
- Careers and WEx drop-in and help with CV's every Tue, Wed, & Thurs before school, break and after school in Room 106
- You must remain in education or training until 18



Raising Attainment

At Blackfen School for Girls we actively seek to raise student attainment and raise student's life chances. We believe that students getting the most out of their lessons is key to students raising their attainment. We aim to build a relationship with your child to direct and support them to realise their potential.

Top Tips for lessons

- Ensure your child packs their bags before school and is prepared and ready with books and equipment for lessons
- Stay focussed in lessons
- Take notes
- Actively listen
- Ask questions
- · Positively engage with peers
- Write down any home work

Top Tips for Home Learning

- If possible, your child will need a designated area where they can work
- We recommend that students don't have access to phones or iPads during home learning
- No music or music without lyrics is usually to learn to
- We recommend that students complete 1 hr of homework per night and 1 hr of revisit and review. There will be a lot of information that students need to retain in their long term memory so regular active revision is key

Top Tips for revision

- Students should ask their teacher of the exam board and then access the curriculum. This
 is usually known as the Specification
- Students should work through their notes and fill any gaps caused by non attendance
- Students should reduce and convert their notes through revision mind maps, infographics, flashcards and pictures
- Students should review these repeatedly
- Students should quick test their knowledge and then test their knowledge on past exam questions

Growth Mindset

Blackfen is a Growth Mindset School.

Carol Dweck, world-renowned Stanford University psychologist, talks about the power of our mindset or our beliefs (especially around challenge). We can either have a Fixed Mindset where we let failure (or even success) define who we are, or a Growth Mindset where we see setbacks as opportunities to grow and improve ourselves. Just like how we learned how to walk, there are many stumbles along the way, but to reach our potential and live the life we desire, it takes practice and perseverance. We always have a choice about which view to adopt for ourselves...and it's never too late to change.

A person with a growth mindset will grow and thrive in their various dimensions of development because they embrace the fact that failure can make them stronger. They are determined and don't give up in the face of setbacks.

People with a fixed mindset, in contrast, avoid challenges – especially ones they perceive that might not make them look "clever." Further, those with a fixed mindset believe they are either good at something or they're not – practice won't make a difference.

Do you have a Growth Mind-set?



- I respond positively to feedback
- I understand that failure is part of learning and nothing to fear
- I realise that effort is the key to success
- I know there is a limit to how far talent can take you
- I believe that practice makes perfect
- I recognise there is no secret formula for academic achievement

- 1. Teach Them It's Okay to Be Wrong.
- 2. Teach Them to Try New Ideas.
- 3. Teach Them to Keep Trying.
- 4. Teach Them to Learn From Mistakes.
- 5. Teach Them to Problem-Solving Skills.
- 6. Teach Them to Talk About Mistakes.
- 7. Don't Expect Perfection.



Mental Health & Wellbeing

At Blackfen, we appreciate that KS4 can be a stressful and worrying time for students. Therefore, we have a range of provisions in place to reduce this stress and reactive provision in the school. Students can talk to their SSO at any time and can be referred to our inhouse counsellor if they need to talk to anyone about how they are feeling. We will also be holding an exam stress workshop that students can sign up to and this will take place in November. We will also continue to post resources on the KS4 teams pages to signpost students for information and wider support. We also signpost students to a range of resources both in CT time and on our Wellbeing board.

Here are some Top Tips for Promoting balanced Wellbeing:

- Please encourage your child to go to bed at a decent time. Students need at least 8 hours deep sleep per night to be effective learners
- Please ensure that your child eats a balanced diet and exercises to promote well being.
- Communicate with your child and encourage them to speak freely about what is on their mind
- Please encourage your child to ask for help if they are feeling overwhelmed
- Encourage your child to take a break and reflect
- Feeling overwhelmed and stressed particularly around exam time is very common. Please encourage your child to give themselves plenty of time to prepare for these challenges
