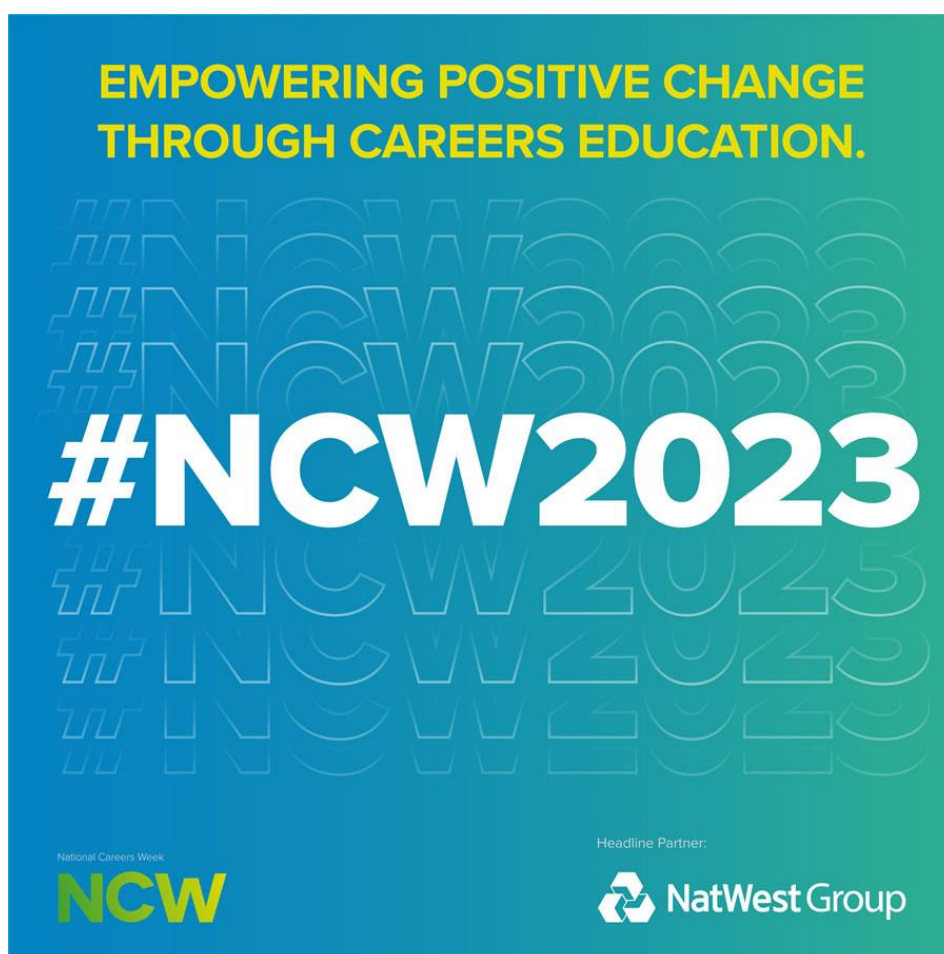

Information has been sent out my email with a reply slip to years 8-13. If you have not returned your reply slip you are still able to attend the Careers Forum between the following times:

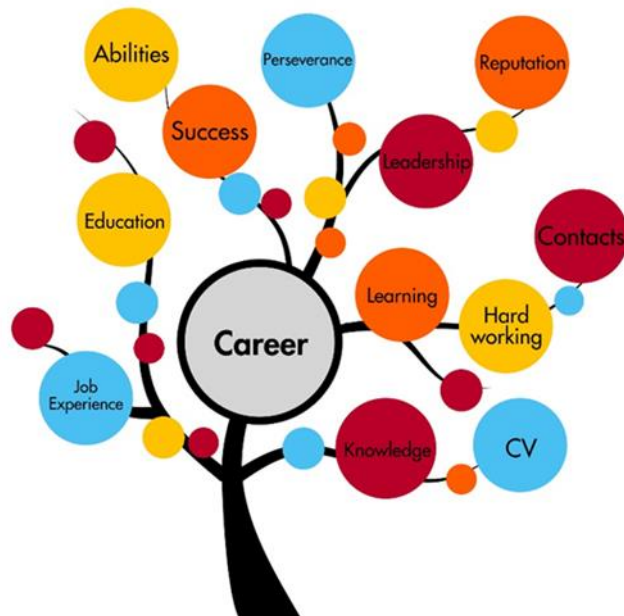
