Reminders

Similarly if your child needs to call home then they should go to their SSO to ask for permission to call home.

Whilst writing I would remind you that if mobile devices are seen, then they will be confiscated. If your child refuses to hand this over then there will be an automatic S4 sanction.

Finally - Shoes. Black shoes are the uniform footwear and should be worn unless there is a medical note stating the reason why. Trainers, boots, vans, sandals etc are not uniform footwear.
