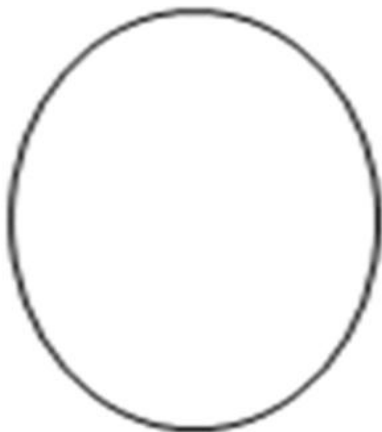
TASK 1: Describe what mood, emotion or feeling each of these colours means to you

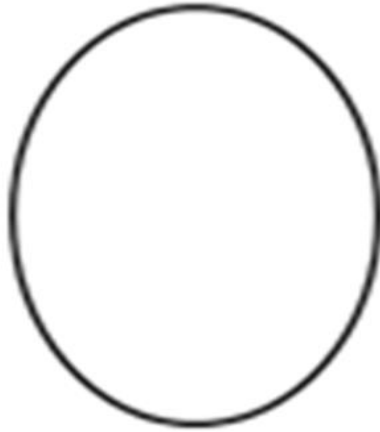
TASK 2: Expressions and emotions

Self-portraits! Using a mirror, draw the six different expressions in the oval shapes.

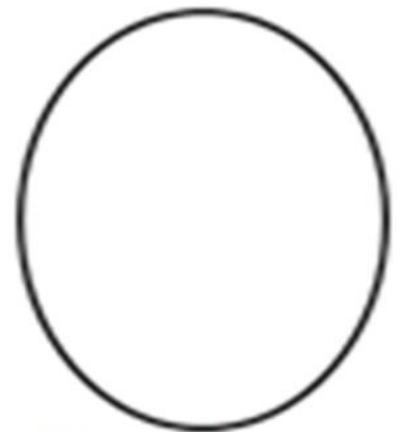
You must include your eyes, ears and nose. You can add colour too. What colour could Puzzlement be? Using a pencil draw the expressions listed below in the oval shape faces.



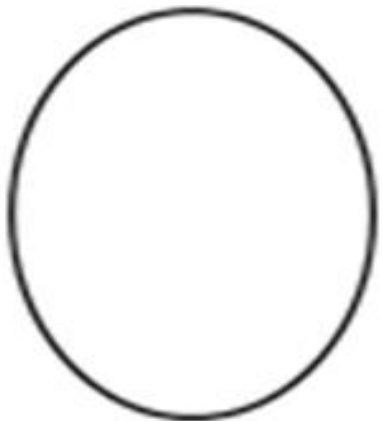

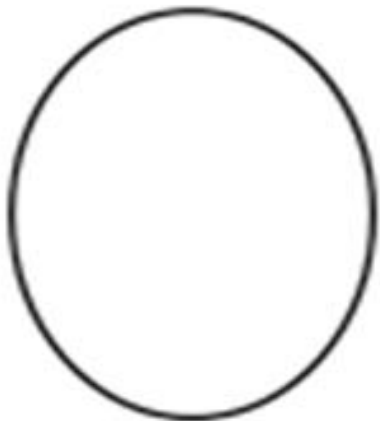

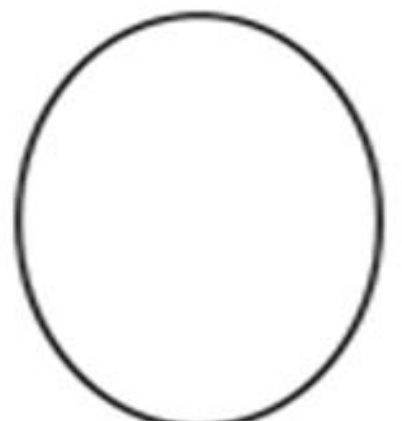
