Dear parents/carers of year 10,

We are now into the 3rd week of year 10 students being in school for lessons in mathematics, science and English. Staff have worked hard to ensure that there are maximum opportunities for students to learn and make gains in their learning. It has been good to see your daughter in school engaging in lessons and seeing some familiar faces in their year group. There has been no new guidance to schools regarding the number of students allowed in school at this time. It still can be no more than 25% of the total of students on roll, in years 10 and 12, in school at any one time.

We continue to think about what September will look like and, as at the time of writing, I am still waiting for the guidance on this. In the meantime, we will continue to offer the opportunity for your daughter to be in school for one 4 hour taught session a week. This will be for the last 2 weeks of term starting on Monday 6 July 2020 and will serve to supplement their remote learning which remains the predominant form of learning for year 10 students.

During the last 2 weeks of term your daughter will remain in the same bubble and will continue to attend school on the day and at the time that she has been for the last few weeks. She will have lessons in English and mathematics during week beginning 6 July and science and English during week beginning 13 July 2020.

We look forward to seeing your daughter in school for these sessions. Please follow the normal procedure if your daughter is unable to attend on that day.

I will be sending you some further communication on the situation for September as soon as this has been finalised.
