It has been so good to see year 10 students back in school this week in their English and mathematics lessons. I know that they have warmly welcomed the opportunity to be in school and staff have also enjoyed being able to teach face-to-face.

Some reminders for next week:

- Please continue to ring in on the day if your daughter is unable to attend on the day. It is very important that we know this information as soon as possible.
