- Careful and comprehensive advice and support about careers, both in education and employment.
- A genuine concern for the welfare and development of all students. Staff are available for consultation and guidance and outside agencies can be sought when needed. No Student should ever feel that there is no one on the staff to turn to.
- A tutor, who monitors your progress, provides guidance and assistance in setting targets for improvement.
- Revision and extra lessons as and when needed.
- The opportunity to take part in extra curricular and enrichment activities

In return, you will be expected to;

- Wear (at all times) the ID lanyard and swipe cards

- Not smoke on or near to the school site (this will result in internal exclusion).

- Bring in correct equipment, planner and conduct card every day.
