DISCOVER 2026 – In school activities information

As part of the Discover 2026 programme for KS3 students, your child may have been selected to take part in one of the following in school activities. Please familiarise yourselves with the information for the relevant activities, and ensure that your child is properly prepared and equipped for the day.

Students are not required to wear school uniform, but should ensure they are dressed appropriately (i.e. no shorts above mi-thigh/ripped jeans or crop tops, and no false nails or lashes). If students decide to bring electrical items with them, the school will not take any responsibility if anything is lost or damaged during the day.

Rooming for the in-school activities is yet to be finalised. A schedule for rooming will be shared with parents via Edulink and the school website closer to the time. The schedule will also be available in school for students closer to the time.

Activities on the day

Paid activities

- **Accessory Workshop £3.00** – Students will use a range of materials to create hair accessories that to suit their own tastes, that they can then take home to enjoy or gift to somebody. All material supplied. The costs of this activity are to cover the materials required.
- **Axe Throwing & Rock Climbing £29.00** – Students will be working with a team of professionals to spend an exciting half-day learning the skill of axe throwing, and scaling a 10-metre climbing wall. Sports wear is required for safety reasons, i.e. leggings, t-shirt and trainers. There is no need to purchase special items for this activity. The costs for this activity are to cover the external provider.
- **Bath bomb workshop £6.00** – Students will be making bath bombs that they will be able to take home to enjoy or gift to somebody. All material supplied. The costs of this activity are to cover the materials required.
- **Friendship Scrapbook £8.50** – Students will use photographs brought from home along with a variety of craft materials to make a beautiful keepsake to take home with them or gift to a loved



one. Students should bring either a small scrapbook or a photo frame with them. The costs of this activity are to cover the craft materials required.

- **Great Blackfen bake off £12.00** – Students will be guided through baking a beautiful cake that they can then collect at the end of the day to share with those at home. Students should bring a suitable container in which to carry their cake home. All ingredients will be provided. The costs of this activity are to cover the materials required.
- **Henna workshop £4.00** – Students will be guided through creating beautiful mehndi using henna. They will leave the workshop with their henna mehndi proudly displayed on their hands or arms. The costs of this activity are to cover materials.
- **Knitting and crochet £6.00** – Students will have the opportunity to discover and practice knitting, crochet and some sewing skills with the help of staff who are knowledgeable in these areas. All materials supplied. The costs of this activity are to cover materials.
- **Mad Science £6.00** – Students will be undertaking wild and wacky science experiments to create all manner of weird and wonderful things. The costs of this activity are to cover materials.
- **Quilling £9.50** – Students will learn how to roll, shape and design beautiful paper art using colourful quilling strips and specialist tools. They'll have the chance to create their own unique masterpieces and even frame their favourite piece in a deep box frame to take home. The costs of this activity are to cover materials.
- **Wicked Workshop £12** – Students will spend 2.5 hours immersed in the land of Oz with a cast member from the hit West End musical, Wicked. They will work through a variety of songs and ensemble pieces, getting a real glimpse into the exciting world of theatre performance art. Sportswear required for ease of movement. The costs for this activity are to cover the external provider.
