DISCOVER 2025 – Wednesday 15th July 2026, The Devil Wears Prada-£42

As part of the Discover 2026 programme for KS3 students, your child has been selected to attend the trip to 'The Devil Wears Prada' on Wednesday 15th July 2026.

Students are not required to wear school uniform for the trip, please ensure they are wearing clothes that are suitable for a practical dance/drama/singing workshop. If students decide to bring electrical items with them, the school will not take any responsibility if anything is lost or damaged during the trip.

Activities on the day

Students will have a 90-minute music and movement workshop with a cast member from The Devil Wears Prada at 11.30am. Following this, the students will have time to purchase and eat their lunch in Tottenham Court Road before taking their seats in the stalls of the theatre to enjoy the matinee performance of The Devil Wears Prada at 14.30.

Transport

Students will travel by train from Bexley Station to London Charing Cross, they will then take the underground to Dance Works Dance Studios for their movement and music workshop. They will then travel on to Tottenham Court Road for lunch and the theatre. The return journey will be the same but in reverse. **As the return journey will take place after 4.30pm, we are unable to secure free transport through TfL, therefore all students will require an Oyster/Zip card with at least £10 on it.**

Timings of the trip

Students are expected to meet school staff outside the **front entrance of Bexley Train Station by 09.30am, the train will depart at 09.48am.** Students and staff will return to Bexley Train Station by approximately 6.00pm and will be dismissed from there.

Cost of the trip

The cost of the visit will be **£42** which includes tickets to the matinee performance of 'The Devil Wears Prada' and the 90-minute music and movement workshop. **The deadline for payment is 1st May 2026.**
