

## Summer School Provision report

Pupils leaving primary school this year may have missed a significant proportion of key stage 2 face-to-face teaching and therefore missed valuable preparation for secondary education. They are likely to need additional support with English and maths, for example, to make it easier for them to access the secondary curriculum. Our summer school gave us an ideal opportunity to offer that face-to-face support before students started with us in September.

We also wanted to support pupils' wellbeing and included enrichment activities, such as team games, music, drama and sports.
