

Technically speaking, no genetic connection is required to prove parenthood with married couples. So, what happens in surrogacy arrangements, and other methods where children are conceived with the help of assisted reproductive technologies? Who is mum and dad? This session will look at the confusing world of parenthood and explore some curious case law where the current legal methods for assigning 'mother' and 'father' have clearly failed to meet the intention of the parties involved.
