The School will provide for you;

- Initial and continuing guidance about courses to meet your needs.
- Appropriate teaching, setting and marking of homework and coursework. Regular grade checks and assessment of performance.
- Facilities and resources for study and the encouragement to acquire good learning skills and habits. (The Sixth Form Block is open for student use from 7.30am – 4.30pm).
- Careful and comprehensive advice and support about careers, both in education and employment.
- A genuine concern for the welfare and development of all students. Staff are available for consultation and guidance and outside agencies can be sought when needed. No Student should ever feel that there is no one on the staff to turn to.
- A tutor, who monitors your progress, provides guidance and assistance in setting targets for improvement.
- Revision and extra lessons as and when needed.
- The opportunity to take part in extra curricular and enrichment activities

WHAT WE ASK OF YOU IN ORDER TO ENSURE YOUR OWN DEVELOPMENT AND SUCCESS

Student expectation:

- Wear (at all times) the ID lanyard and swipe cards
- Respect others and their property at all times.
- Maintain a high level of attendance at all times. In any case of absence, it is the student's responsibility to ensure they catch up on any work they miss. All post-16 courses are intensive and students can't afford to miss valuable teaching and study time. Students should aim for at least 97% attendance for the year. An exemplary record of attendance shows that a student is well-motivated, dedicated, organised and takes their responsibilities seriously. We provide information about attendance and punctuality when asked to provide references for UCAS and other applications. In Accordance with the EFSA funding guidance, students will lose their right to free examination entry if their attendance is unacceptable, or if it means they have not completed necessary work.
- Arrive on time to school (8.20am).
- Arrive promptly to each lesson, Study sessions and CT.
- Make up all 'lates' time on a Monday at the end of student's day.
- Demonstrate a growth mind set to maintain good standards of work and meet course requirements.
- Complete all homework, coursework and assignments to set deadlines.
- Attend all lessons and study periods.
- Use study time effectively.
- Be available to staff who need to see you at time when you have no timetabled lessons (This may need to be before school, during breaks or after school.) Students should not take on paid work, make routine appointments or have driving lessons during the school day (8.30–3.00). Part of the reason for this is that our curriculum includes days where students may have changes to their usual timetabled lessons and 'free periods'; including assessments, enrichment days, educational visits, Challenge Days and PSHRE sessions.
- Not take holidays during term time.
- Students cannot have or consume energy drinks on the school site.
- Students cannot use or be seen with a mobile phone or headphones (other than in the Sixth Form designated area). If seen they will be confiscated and returned after school.
- Act as a positive role model for younger students.
- Contribute to the life of Blackfen including whole school activities, enrichment, year meetings and challenge days.
- Adhere to the Sixth Form dress code (including during exams). Please note: Students can be sent home for violation of dress code.
- Not smoke/vape on or near to the school site (this will result in internal exclusion).
- Bring in correct equipment, ID swipe lanyard every day.
