DISCOVER 2024 – Thursday 18th July, Cineworld O2 - <mark>£10</mark>.

As part of the Discover 2024 programme for KS3 students, your child has been selected to attend the trip to Cineworld at the O2 on Thursday 18th July 2024.

Students are not required to wear school uniform for the trip, but should ensure they are dressed appropriately (i.e. no shorts above mid-thigh/ripped jeans or crop tops and no false nails or lashes). If students decide to bring electrical items with them, the school will not take any responsibility if anything is lost or damaged during the trip.

Activities on the day

Students will spend the day travelling to the O2, be given a private viewing of a **surprise** film (this will be the latest cinema release), then have some time to explore the O2 and get some lunch.

Transport

132 Bus from Blackfen School to the O2 Greenwich and back (students will need to bring their Oyster ZIP card for this).

Timings of the trip

Students are expected to meet in the school canteen at 8.30am. We will then leave together and return to the school at 2.30pm where they will be dismissed from the school site.

Cost of the trip

The cost of the visit will be £10 which includes private viewing of latest cinema release, some popcorn and a drink. The deadline for payment is **Wednesday 1st May 2024.** Payments can be made in instalments by selecting the 'Pay my own amount' option on Wisepay. We are now a cashless school, so payments must therefore be made via Wisepay (our on-line payment portal). You can access our school payment system by:

• **School Website** - Click on the credit card icon in the top right hand corner of the home page and it will take you directly to the portal.

• **Wisepay App for mobile phones** - This is available for parents to download. Please note the Blackfen organisation code to download the App is 66447546. All this information can be found on our school website (blackfenschoolforgirls.co.uk).

- A fully charged mobile phone that is capable of making calls (has credit)
