DISCOVER 2024 – Wednesday 17th July, V & A ‘Naomi’ Exhibition **£10.00**

As part of the Discover 2024 programme for KS3 students, your child has been selected to attend the trip to the V & A ‘Naomi’ Exhibition on Wednesday 17th July 2024.

Students are not required to wear school uniform for the trip, but should ensure they are dressed appropriately (i.e. no shorts above mid-thigh/ripped jeans or crop tops and no false nails or lashes). If students decide to bring electrical items with them, the school will not take any responsibility if anything is lost or damaged during the trip.

Activities on the day

Students will be taken to the Victoria & Albert Museum in South Kensington, a global destination for art, design & performance. Students will explore the galleries freely before visiting the ‘Naomi’ Fashion exhibition, The 1st exhibition of its kind. Exploring the extraordinary career of fashion model Naomi Campbell. Celebrating her creative collaborations, activism & cultural impact.

Transport

Train from Sidcup train station to Charing Cross, walk to Embankment station and take the underground District Line to South Kensington. We have applied for free train travel via TfL, however it is advisable to plan for contingencies. Please ensure that students have a valid ZIP card, if they don't have a ZIP card then please ensure that they have an oyster card with them that has at least £10 travel credit.

Timings of the trip

Students are expected to meet at the front entrance of Sidcup Train Station by 9:30am in order to catch the 9.49am train to Charing Cross.

The return journey will involve catching the 2.00pm train from Charing Cross, arriving at Sidcup Train Station at 2.35pm where they will be dismissed.

Cost of the trip

The cost of the visit will be **£10.00** that includes train travel and entry to the museum, and the deadline for payment is **Wednesday 1st May 2024**. Payments can be made in instalments by selecting the ‘Pay my own amount’ option on Wisepay. We are now a cashless school, so



payments must therefore be made via Wisepay (our on-line payment portal). You can access our school payment system by:

- **School Website** - Click on the credit card icon in the top right hand corner of the home page and it will take you directly to the portal.
- **Wisepay App for mobile phones** - This is available for parents to download. Please note the Blackfen organisation code to download the App is 66447546. All this information can be found on our school website (blackfenschoolforgirls.co.uk).

What students are required to bring for the day:

- Oyster or ZIP card
- Suitable shoes for walking (trainers or converse)
- A bottle of water
- Sun screen
- A hat
- A fully charged mobile phone that is capable of making calls (has credit)
