Privacy Notice - Data Protection Act 1998

We, Blackfen School for Girls, are the Data Controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act. We collect information from you, and may receive information about you from your previous school. We hold this personal data and use it to:

- support your teaching and learning;
- monitor and report on your progress;
- provide appropriate pastoral care, and
- assess how well your school is doing.

This information includes your contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information, characteristics such as ethnic group, special educational needs and any relevant medical information.

We will not give information about you to anyone outside the school without your consent unless the law and our rules permit it.

We are required by law to pass some of your information to Bexley (our Local Authority), and the Department for Education (DFE).

Youth Support Services Agreement - Once you are aged 13 or over we are required to pass on certain information to the YSSA services. YSSA is the government's information and advice service for all young people aged 13 to 19 in England.

We must provide both your own and your parent/s' name/s and address/es and any further information relevant to the YSSA services' role.

However, students (if over 16) or parents can ask that no information beyond name and address be passed to YSSA. Please inform the school office if you wish to opt-out of this arrangement. For more information about YSSA please, contact Bexley, our Local Authority, as shown above.

SIMs In Touch Email – The school makes use of the In Touch service for electronic communications to parents. This involves the secure sharing of a limited amount of student and contact data.

WisePay –The school is using WisePay services for on-line payments. WisePay provides the school with a secure automated payment collection point for anything from school lunches through to school trips and curriculum resources. Parents can pay online with their debit or credit card at any time. This involves sharing a limited amount of students and contact data.
